## GHANA POLICE CHURCH PLANTED



### Testimony from Pastor Patrick Kobina Bremansu - The Church of Pentecost Mahodwe

I've been in ministry for many years, faithfully laboring in the fields and trusting God for a harvest. But if I'm honest, I had never experienced a significant breakthrough in terms of souls won. Over the course of my many outreaches, we've seen a few here and there—maybe 3 souls at most from each event. I always believed in the power of the gospel, but I was beginning to wonder if we were ever going to see a true outpouring of harvest in our area.

Then God sent Godfred to us, and everything changed. He came to lead film evangelism rallies in our community, showing powerful films like Final Account. From the very first event, there was a palpable shift in the atmosphere. The message hit hearts in ways we couldn't have imagined.

That day, **71 souls** gave their lives to Christ. **71!** In just one day! I was completely overwhelmed, and it was such a humbling reminder that God has different vessels for different missions. I had been faithful with the tools I had, but Godfred's ministry through film evangelism reached people in ways I couldn't have. It was a divine partnership, and I realized that God uses various methods and people to bring in His harvest.
