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Living Bread and Resurrection Power Ministry Leaders' Training: A Moment of Transformation

The Living Bread and Resurrection Power Ministry took a bold step toward strengthening its leadership and vision for high performance and church growth. I trained the **411** church leaders in the Accra West and Accra East zones, leaders gathered for an empowering experience aimed at aligning the church's leadership with its core theme of high performance and growth.

The training brought together **271** church leaders from the Accra West zone and **140** leaders from the Accra East zone, marking a significant moment for the ministry's future. The program, designed to equip church leaders with essential tools and knowledge for both spiritual and practical leadership, proved to be a powerful experience for all participants. Attendees engaged in deep discussions, practical exercises, and reflection sessions, which all centred around building a thriving church community that embodies high performance.

The General Overseer of the Living Bread and Resurrection Power Ministry, Archbishop Akwasi Asare Bediako shared his heartfelt reflections on the training's significance. He emphasised that the church's growth and high performance are intricately tied to the empowerment and alignment of its leadership. "This training is not just a session but a pivotal moment for each of you as leaders. It is about nurturing leadership that reflects our theme – building growing and high-performance church," Archbishop Akwasi Asare Bediako explained.



He went on to share a personal testimony that deeply resonated with many of the attendees. "This picture booklet that we used for training today is the very same resource I used over 30 years ago to convert some of the prominent pastors in this country," Archbishop Akwasi Asare Bediako recalled. His story of how the picture booklet played a role in shaping key church leaders served as an inspiring reminder of the power of continuous learning and leadership development. "What began as a tool to inspire a few has grown to touch many lives, and now, it's touching yours," he said.
