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LIGHT SHINES AT KUKRUBOASE

In a quiet village nestled in the heart of the Ashanti Region - Kukruboase, there was a school unlike any other. Kukruboase Primary School is a place where young minds gathered, eager for knowledge but untouched by the stories and teachings that many of us take for granted. For these 125 children in the school, the word "Bible" was merely a concept—they had never seen a physical Bible nor heard its stories spoken in the rhythms of faith. Their lives were simple and rooted in traditions passed down through generations, but faith and the scriptures were distant, almost foreign.

Great Commission Movement of Ghana recognised this gap when the team went for mission outreach to Kukruboase. Mr. Asare, the headmaster, and his teachers had been doing their best to introduce these children to the teachings of the Bible, relying on their mobile phones to share verses and stories of the Bible. Yet, despite their best efforts, something was missing. The children, though captivated by the recitation from their teachers, still couldn't grasp the fullness of what was being taught. The Bible, in all its weight and beauty, had yet to truly come alive for them.

The team (Great Commission Movement of Ghana) sensed that this was a divine opportunity, one that was not just about teaching children but also about bringing light to an entire community. As the children gathered in the schoolyard one sunny afternoon, Mr. Asare made an announcement that would change everything.

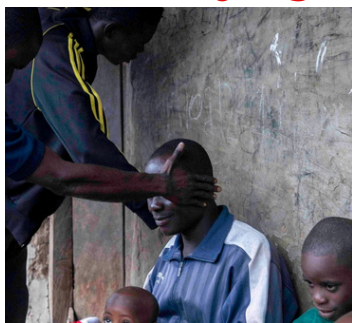
